Top tips for submitting a best practice/service improvement abstract

This infographic has been adapted from guidance originally developed by the IPCRG.

State the problem the change is trying to address

Specify who has made/is making the change, and/or who benefits

Include measures: more measures, less text is a good way to think

Provide evidence of the change (we can learn from changes that are not improvements)

Consider how it is relevant for a wider international PCRS audience

Include a final message: so what have you learned that you want to share?

Avoid presenting a literature review, we want an analysis of a real service change

In the limited time and space focus on the change not the background

Check it is within the allowed word count (300 words)
