



## At-Risk Registers Integrated into primary care to Stop Asthma crises in the UK

An NIHR-funded UK-wide research study to reduce the occurrence of severe asthma related events.

### Why take part?

- Reduce unplanned admissions and improve general care
- Paid research costs
- Bespoke eLearning training programme to facilitate pathways of asthma care across your practice
- Everyone knows a register is good practice, but can be challenging to do on your own. We will provide an easy to implement tool and support to create one

### What is involved?

- A small amount of your IT time to upload the risk stratification tool to your system

For practices randomised to the intervention arm of the study:

- You can modify the list based on your knowledge of your patients
- Two online eLearning training sessions (up to 45 minutes each) and a 30 minute webinar for members of your team - at least one GP, nurse, dispensing and reception staff member.

Control practices will be able to take up the intervention after a year of follow up as a control site in the study.

NB. Data required for this study data is extracted anonymously from routine practice data at the end of the 1 year study period.
